## Polarion for Subversion 2.6 Release Now Available

New release of Application Lifecycle Management (ALM) solution for Subversion

**Stuttgart, Germany, October 18, 2006** — Polarion Software, creators of fully integrated application lifecycle management solutions and services, today announced version 2.6 of Polarion for Subversion, the company's technology-leading Application Lifecycle Management solution. Polarion for Subversion 2.6 integrates Requirements, Change Management and Project Planning into a web-based client server solution for use with the increasingly popular open-source Subversion version control system (VCS).

The new version contains numerous improvements and extensions. Among the most notable are:

- **Support for CMMI:** The CMMI (Capability Maturity Model Integration) self-assessment feature checks projects against CMMI Level 2 practices and displays the results. Users can check "live" whether software projects correspond to the CMMI guidelines.
- **Microsoft Project Integration**: Import and further process MS-Project planning data. If required, the data can be also exported back into MS-Project.
- **Time recording:** Different employees can record time needed for various Work Items such as requirements, change requests, tasks, etc.
- Enhanced Build Reports: Finished Work Items such as bugs or change requests are indicated in Build reports. This functionality is highly configurable.
- New integration: Integration in the JUnit testing solution of Agitar Software, "Agitar One"
